

Morris and Mayfield named All-Americans

KANSAS CITY, Mo. – The 2024 NAIA Women's Beach Volleyball All-Americans were announced today, with USK's Alexcis Morris and Anne Mayfield named to the Second Team. The pair become the only USK beach volleyball players in program history to earn All-American recognition.

The All-American teams are selected by the NAIA-BVCA Executive Committee, with only regular season success considered. A total of 16 pairs are honored as All-Americans, eight on each team. Pairs must play 66% of their matches in the same lineup spot in order to be eligible.

Morris and Mayfield spent the entire season at the 1's position for the Firebirds. The duo went 12-5 in the regular season, with an 11-2 mark versus NAIA opponents. A 7-1 record in California Pacific Conference matches also helped USK secure the regular season conference championship and contributed to Morris and Mayfield being named the Cal Pac Pair of the Year.

Morris is a senior from Menifee, California. The accolade is her second All-American honor this year as she was also named to the Second Team for indoor volleyball. In addition, the blocker was named the Cal Pac Player of the Year in both beach and indoor volleyball.

Mayfield is a redshirt sophomore from Placentia, California. The split joined USK ahead of this season, which ended with Mayfield being named First Team All-Conference.
